- **Philippians 3:5–6** » (I was) ⁵ circumcised the eighth day, of the nation of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the Law, a Pharisee; ⁶ as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to the righteousness which is in the Law, found blameless.
- Acts 7:58 » the witnesses laid aside their robes at the feet of a young man named Saul.
- Acts 26:10-11 » "And this is just what I did in Jerusalem; not only did I lock up many of the saints in prisons, having received authority from the chief priests, but also when they were being put to death I cast my vote against them. ¹¹ And as I punished them often in all the synagogues, I tried to force them to blaspheme; and being furiously enraged at them, I kept pursuing them even to foreign cities."

- **2 Corinthians 4:15** » that the grace which is spreading to more and more people may cause the giving of thanks to abound to the glory of God.

Ways We See God's Sanctifying Grace:

A)

2 Peter 1:3 » His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

Philippians 4:19 » And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

B)

1 Timothy 4:16 » Pay close attention to yourself and to your teaching; persevere in these things, for as you do this you will ensure salvation both for yourself and for those who hear you.

Ephesians 6:12 » For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places.*

C) _____

2 Timothy 2:16–18 » But avoid worldly *and* empty chatter, for it will lead to further ungodliness, ¹⁷ and their talk will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, ¹⁸ *men* who have gone astray from the truth saying that the resurrection has already taken place, and they upset the faith of some.

- **1 Corinthians 5:5** » deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- **Hebrews 12:6-11** » Those whom the Lord loves, He disciplines... ¹¹ All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful, yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.
